If you are a beginner looking to learn micropigmentation, we recommend learning brows first. You can be taught both hair stroke and ombré/powder techniques. This is the most popular treatment in micropigmentation. You can then progress to lip micropigmentation and finally eyeliner micropigmentation, once you have mastered confidence and control in your technique and skill level. In some circumstances it will be possible to embark on all 3 techniques as a longer course, however be careful not to overwhelm yourself with too much in one go.

Training is open to all students irrespective of your background and beauty, aesthetics or otherwise. Courses are delivered to a maximum of 2 students at a time, this ensures a more attentive learning experience for students to allow confidence and skills to develop easily.

A £1000 deposit towards the course cost is required to secure your place and bookings must be made in advance.

This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Full payment must be made in full no later than 3 weeks before the course.

Some of our courses include an online theory element.

Cancellations cannot be made after the theory sections are accessed.

Students that act inappropriately or act dangerously will be dismissed or asked to leave.

Students may be required to pair up and work on each other.

All students are responsible for their own clients/models to work on and demonstrate the practical skills during the course unless otherwise advised.
